RVN's **Kentucky Derby Pub Crawl** on Saturday, May 4th, 2019 was a resounding success. The crawlers ate and drank at Roscoe Village Pub, Village Tap, Commonwealth Tavern and Four Treys. There was a raffle and prizes were awarded to the best-dressed participants. Nearly \$2,000 was raised for Common Pantry.

The 2019 annual **RVN Community Garage Sale** in June had 39 participating homes in RV and welcomed people from all over Chicago, who found unique treasures and fantastic deals. This event held in June has grown to include other neighborhoods, making it a huge Chicago community garage sale event.

On July 14, 2019, garden enthusiasts came from all over the city to see the Village in bloom! RV residents once again opened their beautiful gardens to the public in the annual **Roscoe Village Garden Walk**.



RVN's biggest and most important event for the community, the annual **Retro on Roscoe** festival, kicked off a weekend-long series of activities around music, food and antique cars. Thousands of people from all over Chicagoland come to Retro each year, putting this festival on the map. The community relies on this event not only to bring in patrons for local business, but also to raise money that funds The Education Committee grants, NoW Security Camera Program, and allows RVN to give back to residents through beautification projects and neighborhood events. On the morning of October 20th, Roscoe Village streets were filled with over 1,000 runners of all ages, as RVN kicked off its 2nd Annual Halloween 5K and Fun Run. It was quickly followed by the Roscoe Village Halloween Parade and Party, where entire families crowded the streets in their themed costumes and watched. 2019 EDUCATION COMMITTEE UPDATE

In 2019 RVN awarded \$14,925 in Education Grants to neighborhood schools through the administration and recommendations of the RVN Education Committee. It is RVN's way of providing direct funding to support the schools that serve our community.

An additional \$30,000 was given to Audubon to secure smaller class sizes for its primary classrooms, ensure student access to both art and music, and fund a new exterior mosaic. RVN also donated \$1,500 to Jahn to sponsor their 6th Annual North Pole fundraising event.
